Edith Burjan-Lang DO, DPO (A)

Training as an osteopath for children from 1998 to 2000 at the Osteopathic Centre for Children in London; working for the Centre of Osteopathy for Children (Osteopathisches Zentrum für Kinder) in Vienna since 1998

Ass. Prof. Dr. Jane Carreiro DO (USA)

Chairman of the Department of Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine at the University of New England, College of Osteopathic Medicine; her clinical work in the field of osteopathy focuses mainly on children; she is one of the world's leading experts in the field of paediatric osteopathy. Member of the Still-Sutherland study group, faculty of the SCTF, Vice-President of the executive board of WOHO, publication: „Paediatrics from the osteopath's perspective“.

Tajinder K. Deora MSc, Dip Phyt, DO (Hons), DPO (E)

T. Deora's main has been practicing osteopathy since 1983, specialising in paediatric treatment. She has worked for more than 10 years at the Osteopathic Centre for Children (OCC) in London and has made ample experiences in the treatment of infants and toddlers. She is an international lecturer and is currently Head of the clinic at the Osteopathy School Germany (OSD) (Osteopathie Schule Deutschland) in Hamburg. T. Deora is author of the book „Healing through Cranial Osteopathy“ and co-author of the book „Fundamental Osteopathic Techniques“ and „Osteopathic Treatment of Children“ („Osteopathische Behandlung von Kindern“).

Terence Dowling MA, PhB, BA (D)

Studies of medicine, psychology, philosophy and theology. He has been working as a psychotherapist since 1984 with focus on early age disorders and has developed new forms of therapy with autistic children. 1987 Hans Gustav Graber Prize of the ISPPM for the paper „Origin of the Collective Subconscious“. Foundation of the society „Free Life“ („Freies Leben“) in 2003. International lecturer, e.g. at the Osteopathy School Germany (OSD) (Osteopathie Schule Deutschland).

Dr. Viola Frymann DO, FAAO, FCA (USA)

She is a direct student of Sutherland and is considered to be the most experienced osteopath for children worldwide. In 1982 she founded the Osteopathic Centre for Children in California. She is the first person that has undertaken in-depth research in the cranial field and to this day she contributes to scientific research. She is the author of: "The collected writings of Viola Frymann".

Ulrike Hämmerle MSc, DO, DPO (A)

As a co-founder, she has been working in the Osteopathic Centre for Children (OZK) (Osteopathisches Zentrum für Kinder) in Vienna since 1998. She holds a diploma in paediatric osteopathy (DPO). In addition, she trains osteopaths for children at the Osteopathic Centre for Children" in London. She is responsible and works as a lecturer at the Osteopathic Centre for Children in Vienna. In 2001 she has founded the first supervision practice for osteopaths in Vienna, which she manages.

Christina Lenz BSc Ost, MSc Ost Paed, DO, DPO (GB/D)

Academic director of the MSc - programme in paediatric osteopathy at the German School of Osteopathy (OSD) (Osteopathie Schule Deutschland). Roselyne Lalauze-Pol DO (F)

In addition to her studies in osteopathy, Lalauze-Pol holds two university diplomas and has worked 6 years at one of the largest birth centres worldwide (with more than 100 deliveries per day). She also directs clinical research in the field of neonatology at the faculty of medicine in Marseille.

Torsten Liem DO (D), Osteopath GOsC (GB)

Founder of the German School of Osteopathy (OSD) (Osteopathie Schule Deutschland) and of the MSc-programme in paediatric osteopathy, director of the paediatric clinic in Hamburg, author and editor of numerous publications, e.g. „Morphodynamics in the Field of Osteopathy“ and „Osteopathic Treatment of Children“.

Stuart Korth DO (E)

Director of the Osteopathic Centre for Children and Chairman of the Foundation for Paediatric Osteopathy (London). Korth has been committed to the provision of osteopathic services for children for many years and has founded the first teaching institution for paediatric osteopathy in Europe.

Angelika Mückler MSc, DO, DPO (A)

Postgraduate training in paediatric osteopathy in Vienna and London. Works at the OZK since 2001. Member of the Board of the OZK since 2005.

Dr. med. Michel Odent MD (E)

Development of the birth centre at the Pithiviers Hospital in France in the 60s, 70s and at the beginning of the 80s. Known to be specialised in perinatal medicine, he developed water births and homely places of birth. As a researcher he founded the Primal Health Research Centre in London (UK), which focuses on researching the long term consequences of early experiences. Author of approximately 50 articles in the medical literature and 11 books in 21 languages. „The Roots of Love“ („Die Wurzeln der Liebe“), „In Harmony with Nature“ („Im Einklang mit der Natur“) and „The Risk of Caesarean Sections“ („Risiko Kaiserschnitt“) are his newest publications in German.

Pierre Tricot DO (F)

Has been working as an osteopath since the beginning of the 70s and is considered to be one of France's most experienced and most inspiring osteopaths. He combines his areas of expertise which are a special

osteopathic approach to tissues and the treatment of children. Since Pierre Tricot travels rarely, we are particularly pleased that we have managed to invite him to Berlin – after more than 4 years of trying. His published books: „Approche tissulaire de l'osteopathie – un modèle du corps conscient“ and others.

Dr. med. Beatrix Urbanek MSc, DO, DPO, MSc (A)

Gynaecologist with a PhD, homeopath. Her thesis dealt with the question: Do 3 month olds that have been seen and treated by an osteopath right after birth have a different behaviour with regard to screaming, sleeping and digestion than other 3 months old that have not been seen by an osteopath? She works as a clinical tutor at the paediatric clinic of the German School of Osteopathy in Hamburg (OSD) (Osteopathie Schule Deutschland) since 2005.

Prof. Dr. Frank Willard PhD, DO (HON) (USA)

He is currently one of the most remarkable international lecturers and authors, connecting recent findings in the field of neuroendocrinology, immunology, anatomy and embryology with the field of osteopathy.
